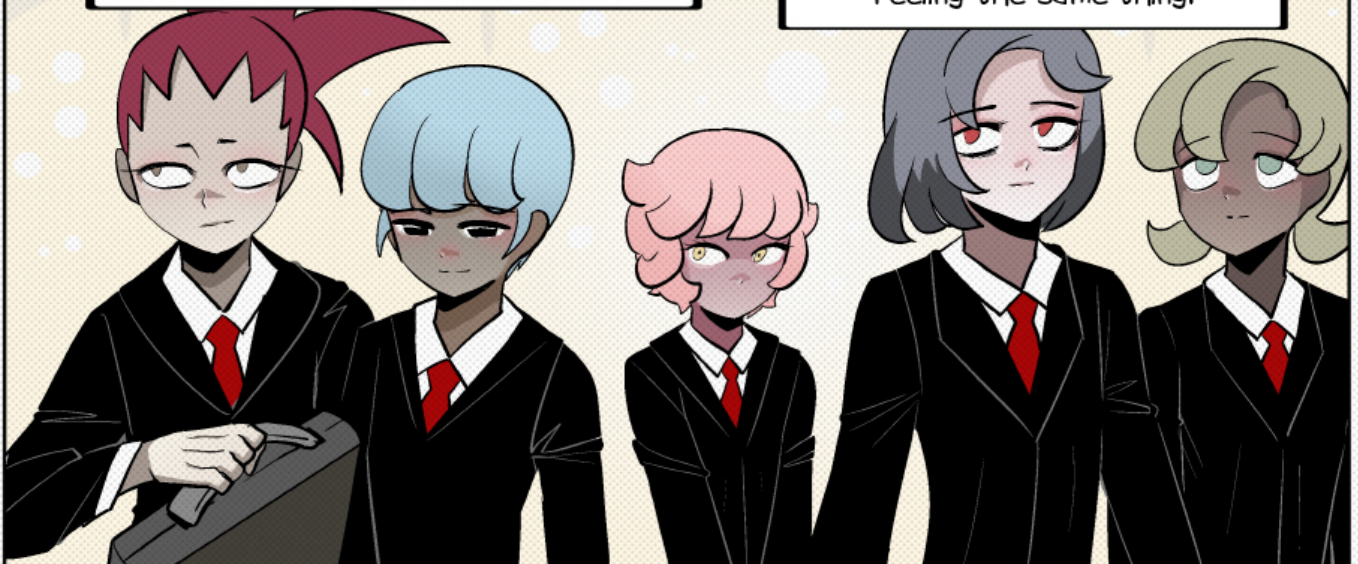
Taii's Diary

in the company...

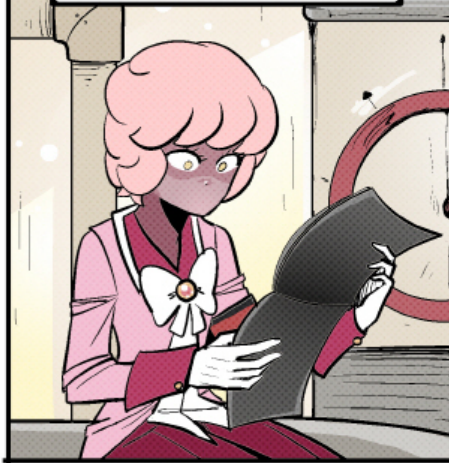
Each person taking this

at the HQ.

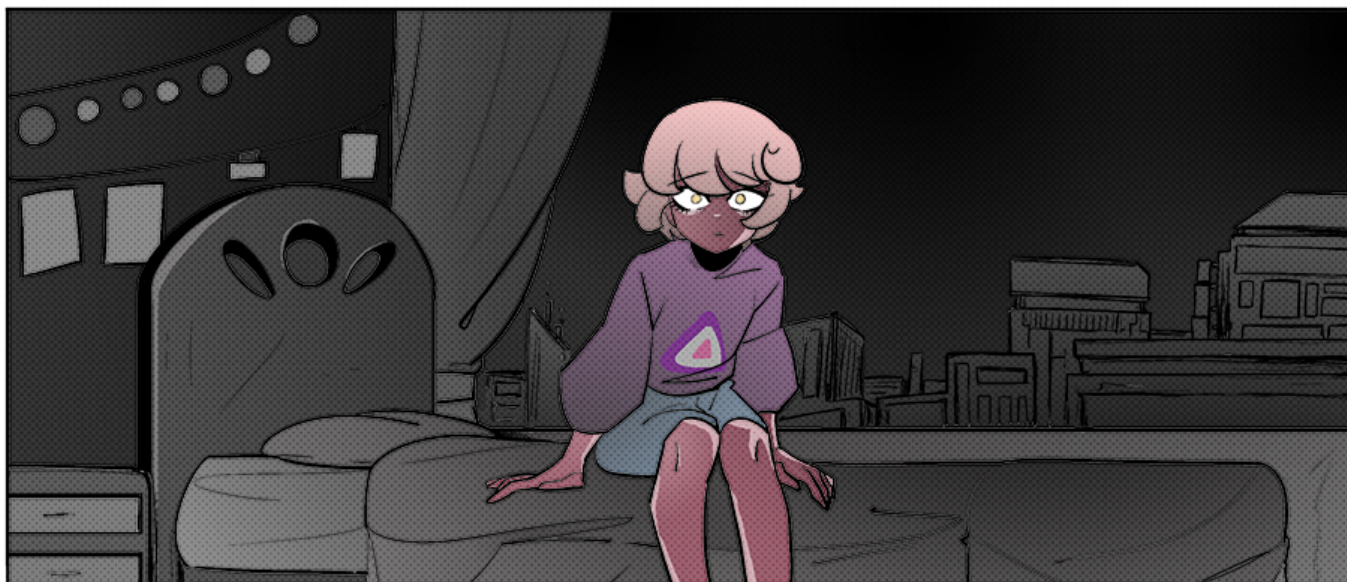


Dunno what it is...

super important.

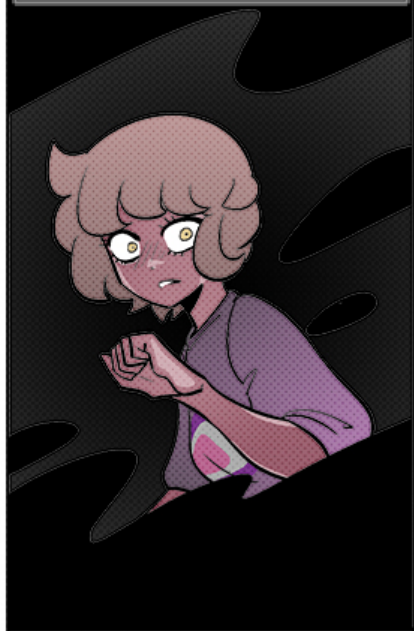
Everyone in the
